### **Beginner Band Program 2022**

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Wollongong Conservatorium of Music and Figtree Public School will continue working together to establish a new Beginner Band in Term 2, 2022.

Students from Years 2 - 5 who are interested in playing a wind or brass instrument, are invited to join the beginner band. Please note;

- Students need NOT have any prior experience to join the band. The program will cater for absolute beginners.
- Basic skills and music literacy will be covered in the band class. It would benefit the students to sign
  up with a teacher at The Wollongong Conservatorium of Music or elsewhere for individual lessons,
  however it is certainly not a requirement at this stage.

#### Instruments offered in beginner band:

FLUTE / CLARINET / SAXOPHONE / TRUMPET / TROMBONE / BARITONE / PERCUSSION / BASS GUITAR

- If you are unsure about instrument choice, clarinet is a good option. The band will sound good with a large number of clarinets, and it is possible to switch easily to saxophone later if the students want to change.
- For the sake of a 'balanced band', places for drums and 'bass guitar' are strictly limited.

**Costs:** The band fee will be approximately \$15/week, however is subject to change slightly based on the number of students in the band. Families will be notified of fees dues and to be paid to the school at the beginning of each term. You will also need to purchase or hire an instrument if you do not already have one.

**Materials:** Students will need to bring the following Items to each rehearsal: (see separate info on instruments and materials):

- Instrument
- method Book 'Essential Elements Book 1'
- plastic sleeve folder for handouts and additional music
- Pencil





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**Commitment:** Beginner Band is a one year commitment. Band works best if all students participate fully. To develop skills and musicianship, students need to be consistent in their attendance at rehearsals and performances. Home practice is also essential. Approximately 20 minutes per day, four times per week is the recommended minimum.

#### **Instruments & Materials - Information for Parents**

### INSTRUMENT (purchase / hire)

Acquiring an instrument is one of the most important aspects of preparing for the students first lessons in band. Regardless of whether you are hiring or buying, new or secondhand — it is definitely worth going for quality.

Please discuss choice of instrument with the band coordinator and conductor during the lead up sessions. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact us with any questions. The band program caters for the following instruments: *flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, trombone baritone, bass guitar, percussion/drums* 

WARNING! Many cheaper wind and brass instruments purchased via the Internet can be very poor quality, and cause significant difficulties with the students' learning. Some reliable name brands for wind and brass instruments are Yamaha, Conn, Jupiter, Selmer, King, Bach. A reputable music shop should be able to give advice on purchasing a quality instrument.

#### METHOD BOOK - Essential Elements Book 1

Our band will use 'Essential Elements Book 1' (Hal Leonard publishing). These books are readily available online and from the music stores mentioned above. Make sure you purchase the book specific to your instrument (eg. Essential Elements Book 1' for Clarinet)





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#### MUSIC STAND

The school will supply music stands for weekly rehearsals, however it is useful for students to have their own music stand for practicing at home. A music stand promotes good posture and makes practicing more efficient and enjoyable.

#### OTHER MATERIALS

In addition to their instrument and method book, students should also bring to each rehearsal; a <u>pencil</u> and a folder with A4 plastic inserts for additional print music and other handouts.

The beginner band program will run AFTER school on Wednesdays from 3.10pm – 4.10pm.
